ADULT INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The Adult Instructional Program offers five skill levels. Lessons are grouped using the N.T.R.P. system. The following descriptions will help the student choose the correct class level.

2.1-2.5 (ADVANCED BEGINNER)

This player needs on-court experience. This player has obvious stroke weaknesses but is familiar with basic positions for singles and doubles play.

2.6-3.0 (LOWER INTERMEDIATE)

This player is learning to judge where the ball is going although court coverage is weak. Can sustain a short rally of slow pace with other players of the same ability.

3.1-3.5 (INTERMEDIATE)

This player is fairly consistent when hitting medium paced shots, but is not comfortable with all strokes and lacks execution when trying for directional control, depth, or power. Most common doubles formation is one-up, one-back.

3.6-4.0 (ADVANCED INTERMEDIATE)

This player has achieved improved stroke dependability with directional control on moderate shots, but still lacks depth and variety. This player exhibits more aggressive net play, has improved court coverage, and is developing teamwork in doubles.

Payment, membership requirement, enrollment, refund and make-up policies:

- Full payment must be included with the registration form. A student enrolling after the start of a session who is unable to make-up missed classes will be charged a pro-rated fee for the remainder of the session.
- 2. Genesis membership is required for adult lessons.
- 3. Fee is non-refundable except as follows:
 - For medical disabilities, a pro-rated refund/credit shall be given from the date the refund is requested when accompanied by a doctor's statement explaining the nature of the disability or injury and duration.
 - A participant shall be given a pro-rated refund/credit should a class be cancelled after the start of the session.
 - A student who does not meet the skill level requirements will be asked to change to a compatible class or will be issues a pro-rated refund or credit.
 - If any class is cancelled, Genesis shall make every make every effort to reschedule the class on a date agreeable to all students. If the class cannot be rescheduled, each participant shall be given a refund or credit for the cancelled class.
 - Only the Director of Tennis, Dave Gary, may approve lesson refunds, credits or pro-rated fees.
- 4. There is a minimum and maximum enrollment for each class.
- 5. Acceptance into a class is based on meeting N.T.R.P. qualifications as noted for each class level.
- Make-ups are not guaranteed. A student may request a maximum of one make-up per session. Make-ups may not be scheduled after completion of the session. Approval of make-up requests are subject to availability of alternate times.
